Service Committee

The Service Committee helps recruit Volunteers for many projects at both the Downtown and Community Campuses. The four Blood Drives per year (Winter, Spring, Summer, Fall) at each campus are our major projects. The next Downtown Campus blood drive is October 12th and 13th. The next blood drive at Community Campus is October 25th and 26th. Power Red (previously called double red cell donation) is done at the Community Campus blood drive. Power Red is similar to a whole blood donation. During this process, the donor is able to safely give a concentrated dose of red cells which are circulated through special machinery after which plasma and platelets are returned to donor when completed.

The Committee had a busy summer assisting with Beautification of the Community Campus by planting flowers in the garden area in front of the hospital.

The Holiday season will be here before we know it and the upcoming projects include decorating at Community Campus and wrapping of gifts at Snowflake Central in Golisano.

The Service Committee is currently working on additional projects but specific details are incomplete at this time. When projects are complete, we will be looking for help from Advocates and Volunteers.
