Family Resource Center

Librarians from the Upstate Health Sciences Library offer research assistance and access to timely, reputable medical literature, internet resources and support services within a welcoming, comfortable environment.

Psychological Support

In addition to cancer care, we treat patients' and families' mental and emotional well-being. Delivered by board certified psychiatrists, our counseling services are an essential component of a patient's treatment plan. Services are available for both group and individual sessions.

Integrative Therapy

Combining conventional therapies and treatments with evidence-guided complementary therapies, treatment of your mind, body, and spirit are the focus of these services.

Nutritional Counseling

Nutrition counseling during the treatment and recovery/ survivorship of cancer is important to the overall health of our patients. We offer individualized patient support and nutrition resources.



Genetic Counseling

Genetic counseling provides a detailed analysis of your medical and family history to assess the likelihood of hereditary cancer. In some families, genetic testing may clarify risks of developing certain cancers and may help an individual in making informed medical decisions for the opportunity of cancer prevention or earlier detection.

Spiritual Care

Our trained non-denominational chaplains offer a compassionate listening presence that can include one-to-one visits and support for you and your loved ones. All are welcome to use our Meditation Room, located on the first floor in the Atrium, or services can be brought to you.

Guest Hospitality

Programs, such as the Room2Smile comfort cart, help to insure that you and your family are made to feel welcome during your time here. We provide activities, resources, and electronic devices such as e-readers.

Tobacco Cessation Counseling

From individual counseling sessions to support groups we can help you and your family members quit smoking. We offer educational materials as well as ongoing in-person and phone support for all patients.

Social Services

Our dedicated Cancer Center social workers are available to assist with a variety of topics that have direct effect on your care and treatment plan.

Financial Counseling

Counselors can help you obtain insurance and provide help in identifying resources to pay for your cancer care.



Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation Therapy
