- Your completed application should not exceed 2 pages plus the Cover Sheet.

PART ONE (Total 10 points)

- 1) List any professional organization memberships and describe your role in that organization.

 <u>Do not</u> include work committees. (5 points)
- 2) List any volunteer or community service activities you have participated in. (5 points)

PART TWO (Total 90 points)

- 1) What inspired your desire to advance your education in Nursing? (30 Points)
- 2) What are your goals and aspirations as they relate to your education, career and future plans? (30 Points)
- 3) Onondaga County Executive Joanie Mahoney has called for a committee to explore and identify health problems and initiatives for the county. She is forming a committee with local politicians, community leaders and health professionals and you have been chosen to participate. Please give a brief but informative idea that should be addressed by the committee and tell why it is important to include on the agenda. (30 Points)
