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## **Medications:**

- Continue your usual medications (except for those listed below) as scheduled. You may take your medications the morning of the procedure.
- Notify our office **NOW** if you are taking **Coumadin** (**Warfarin**), **Plavix**, **Pradaxa**, **or Aggrenox**. These are blood thinning medications and will need to be adjusted the week prior to your procedure.
- Diabetics: If you are taking insulin injections, administer one half your usual dose the day before the procedure. Do not take oral diabetic medication the day prior or morning of test. Do not take your insulin and/or oral medication the morning of your procedure.
- Stop taking iron pills 7 days prior to Colonoscopy.

Because of the medications given to you during the examination, You must have someone accompany you home after you are discharged. If you come without someone, your test will not be done.

- Please bring Insurance cards, photo ID and co-payment to your appointment.
- Patients are responsible for their own parking fees.
- Please leave valuables, i.e. jewelry, at home.
