- Attendings must sign an attestation on each consent form prior to procedures. The form to be used is **#40580**, which is the consent form for diagnostic, therapeutic, invasive, and surgical procedures.
- Discussions with patients and families regarding procedural risks & benefits, complex care planning, goals of care, and complex clinical decision-making should be documented in the medical record.
