<u>Annual Requirements to Maintain Privileges</u> – Annual education and policy review, 1 direct

observation of successful administration via LP and Intraventricular Reservoir

Medical Staff Office will provide final approval of privileges and maintenance of training records. Verification

of privileges is available across the institution within the E-priv application.
