New Users:

All users must be trained before operating the cell analyzers. There is no charge for training. New user training takes approximately 2 hours and includes basic operation of the cell analyzers and trouble-shooting. After this initial training, users may operate the cell analyzers under supervision. After proficiency is demonstrated, users may operate the instruments independently.
