Pin Care

1. Wash your hands.
2. Pour an even amount of saline and peroxide into a cup or bowl.
3. Dip cotton swab into solution.
4. Cleanse around pin in circular motion to remove any drainage.
5. Do not use the same cotton swab on more than one pin.
6. Pins will air dry.
7. Wash hands when done.
8. Monitor for any sign of infection.

Call your doctor if you notice any of these signs.

- redness of area around pin
- any increased drainage from pins
- bad smelling drainage from pins
- fever or chills
