The Advocates for UMU undergraduate scholarships for tuition, fees and required materials, will be awarded to active employees and active adult volunteers, who are pursuing undergraduate studies at a U.S. Department of Education accredited institution in any health profession. **Scholarships for 2024** will be awarded for the FALL SEMESTER ONLY.

- Applicants must be an active employee or volunteer, for a minimum of six months at UMU, Downtown or Community Campuses, **prior to this application deadline.**
- Applicants must be accepted for <u>undergraduate studies</u> directed toward any health profession at an institution which is accredited by the U.S. Department of Education. <u>If you have a BS already in a health profession, you do not qualify.</u>
- Applicant must have completed a minimum of 12 hours of college credit (in studies directed toward any health profession).
- An official college transcript(s) is required with a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.2 or better, as of the deadline date of this application. The committee will give strongest consideration to the most recent academic work.
- Applications must be filled out completely, be signed, and be legible. Please specify your fall semester tuition and required fees.

To be considered for the scholarship, the application <u>must be received in The Advocates office</u>, 750 E. Adams Street, 311 CAB, Syracuse, NY 13210 by NOON, Friday, June 28, 2024.

The Scholarship Committee will review applications and make decisions by August 1.

A check will be sent to the Bursar's Office of the institution to which the applicant has been accepted at the beginning of the Fall Semester. **Checks will not be sent to the recipient.**
