

Sexual & Reproductive Health Services

Appointments are preferred to provide adequate time to meet your needs.

Please bring health insurance card, current contraceptive prescription (if applicable) and have previous exam notes & lab reports sent to Student Health prior to your scheduled appointment.

Please Note: There is no co-pay for the office visit to Student Health, but any lab tests or diagnostic testing does have co-pay requirements as outlined by your Health Insurance provider. Prescription costs are the responsibility of the student after Health Insurance coverage is applied.

Services provided:

- **Gynecological exam:** may include Pap test, STD testing, Clinical Breast Exam, in-office urinalysis)
- **STI screening tests** – lab requisition provided
- **Contraceptive Counseling:** prescriptions for OCP, contraceptive ring, medroxyprogesterone injection, and referrals to community providers for IUD, implantable device, diaphragm/cervical cap.
- **Pregnancy testing** – lab requisition provided
- Generalized sexual & reproductive adult counseling
- Referral for specialized gynecologic care
- **Emergency Contraceptive:** Emergency contraceptive (EC) medication can be purchased without prescription at any local pharmacy with proof of age 17 yrs or older. EC is also available in the cash-only vending machine located in the 1st floor computer lab of the library in Weiskotten Hall.
- **Medication Abortion Services:** We will provide information and referrals to providers in the community who are authorized to prescribe medication abortion.
