^All eligible full-time employees with Attendance Rules coverage are entitled to 13 holidays a year. For classified service employees in the Executive branch of State service who work Monday through Friday with Saturday and Sunday off, Saturday, November 11, 2023 will be observed as a pass day holiday and those eligible employees will earn 7.5 or 8 hours of holiday leave to be used at another time, subject to supervisory approval.

For CSEA employees in the ASU, OSU or DMNA bargaining unit, holiday leave not used one year after the date it is earned expires. Employees in the CSEA ISU, PS&T, RRSU, and M/C bargaining units should be given reasonable opportunity to exhaust holiday leave prior to separation.

This information is subject to change pursuant to direction from the New York State Department of Civil Service and pending results of current contract negotiations.

schedule, staffing for essential services only. Eligible employees in CSEA and PEF bargaining units scheduled, required or directed to a mutually convenient date, or will earn additional pay for time worked based on chosen option. Eligible employees in the UUP bargaining unit, Research Foundation (RF) and Management/ Confidential (M/C) designated employees who are required to work, shall receive a compensatory day off to be used at a mutually convenient date. Eligible UÚP répresented employees who are required to work on New Year's Day may, in addition to their regular compensation for the day, choose to receive straight time holiday pay instead of straight time holiday comp-time for such work.

Thanksgiving and/or Christmas Day will be earned (compensatory time or additional compensation, based on employee's chosen option) at a work on red holidays will earn a compensatory day off to be used at rate of time and one-half. For UUP and CSEA (ASU and OSU only) represented employees and M/C designated employees, accruals (holiday comp) must be used within one year of accrual or forfeited.

> PINK: All Upstate units and departments, including Hospital departments, are on adjusted staffing, based on departmental operating needs and provision of essential services. For UUP represented employees only, the day after Thanksgiving is designated by the President of Upstate as a floating holiday in lieu of Washington's Birthday (observed), All other eligible employees (CSEA, PEF, RF, and M/C) whose requests for time off are approved must charge the time to appropriate

**GREEN:** All hospital services, units and departments continue on regular operative schedules. All other Upstate units and departments must be operative. Departments must: (1) canvass for volunteers; then (2) assign employees on a seniority basis (job function and shift) for staffing sufficient to maintain regular operations, Eligible CSEA and PEF represented employees scheduled or directed to work will earn a compensatory day to be used at a mutually convenient date or will earn additional pay for time worked based on chosen option. Eligible RF, unclassified M/C and UUP represented employees required to work, shall be granted a compensatory day off for use at a mutually convenient date. Washington's Birthday (observed) shall be a regular workday for

represented employees and M/C designated employees, accruals (holiday comp) must be used within one year of accrual or forfeited.

PALE GREEN: For all Upstate units and departments, the State has designated this day as a floating holiday for eligible employees. This designation will apply to both eligible State and RF employees. Employees who are not scheduled to work or are scheduled or directed to work who are eligible to observe holidays, will receive a compensatory day off to be used at a mutually convenient date. The floating holiday may be charged in quarter hour increments for CSEA and PEF represented employees. The accrued holiday must be used no later than February 11, 2024, for CSEA and PEF represented employees.
