

Students may find information including semester start/ end dates and holidays via <u>Upstate's Academic Calendar</u>. Course start/end dates and dates for major examinations can be found on Block Diagrams posted to the <u>Academic Schedules section of the UME Website</u> (usually available for the coming academic year by May).

Access to detailed course schedules will be via Brightspace upon arrival/access to courses in Brightspace courses. We understand that not having this information sooner makes planning difficult. In the meantime, below is are generalized schedules of what students can expect for the first, second and third semesters\* in the 2024-2025 academic year. As one might see, it will be difficult to plan extracurricular activities outside of classwork M-F 8-5pm while class is in session.

## Semesters 1 & 2:
